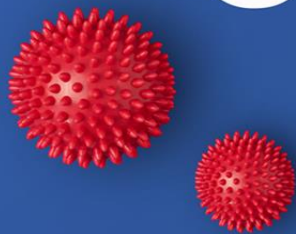

OHIO K-12 SCHOOLS



▶ Vigilantly Assess for Symptoms



▶ Wash and Sanitize Hands to Prevent Spread



▶ Thoroughly Clean and Sanitize School Environment to Limit Spread on Shared Surfaces



▶ Practice Social Distancing



▶ Implement Face Coverings Policy

CCBH



- Daily monitoring for symptoms
- Fever of 100.4° or higher is not the only symptom



COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

Body aches/Chills

Cough/Diarrhea

Fatigue/Headache

Loss of smell or taste

Shortness of breath

Sore throat/Vomiting



- Person to person transmission
- High-touch surfaces
- Community spread



- Isolation of 10 days is required for those who are symptomatic and/or test positive

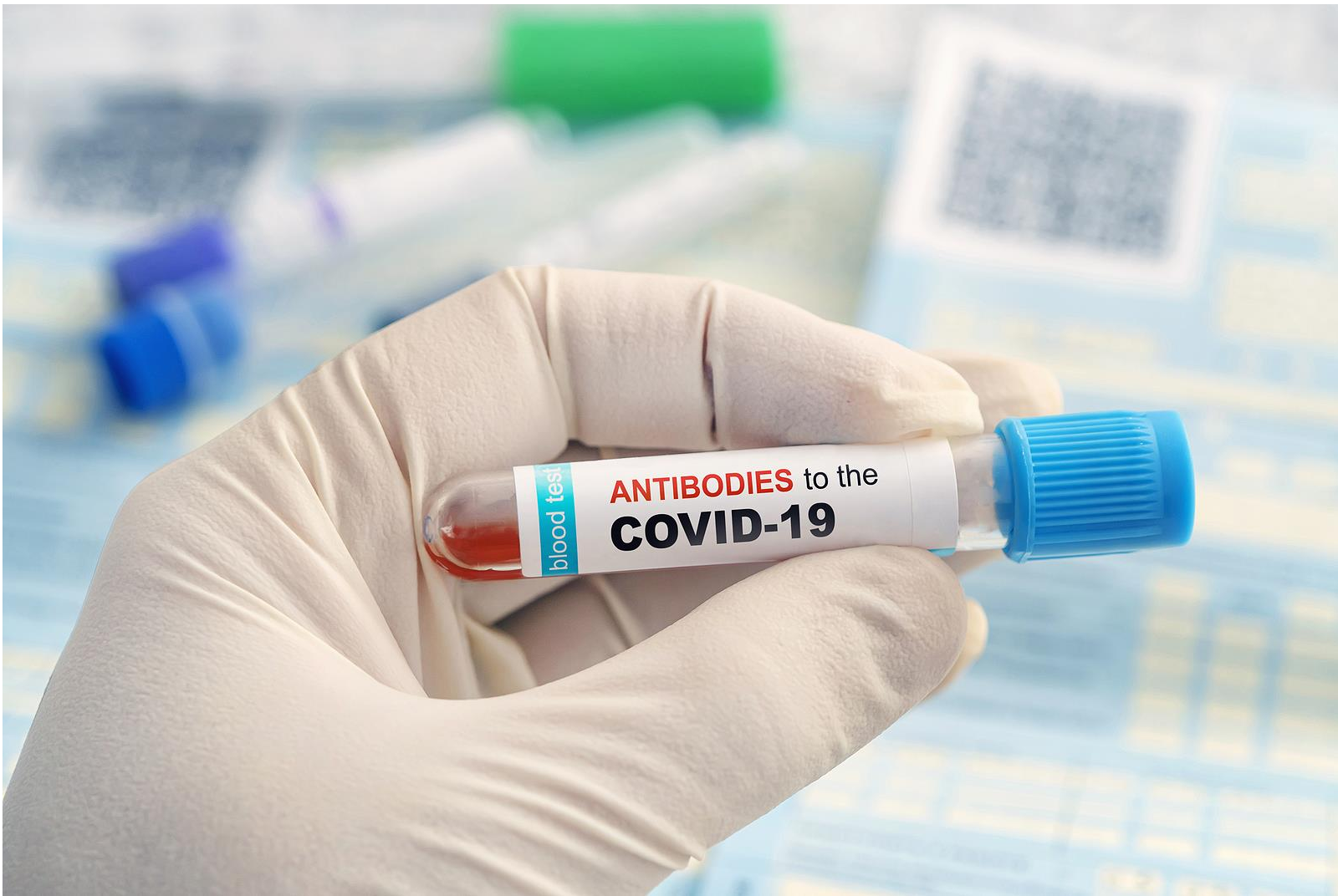


- Quarantine is for those who are not ill but have been exposed



- Community sites and pharmacies
- Urgent cares and hospitals





- Antibody testing can be done to identify if a person had previously contracted COVID-19



- No vaccine or antiviral medication is available

RISK ASSESSMENT



- Need to determine what works for your individual locations and also what is considered safe









- Place sanitizer dispensers in areas where they can easily be seen by everyone



- Wipe down surfaces before the next student arrives
- Place wipes in convenient areas



- Everyone must get on board and be a part of the solution



- Employees must have their nose, mouth and chin covered.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

6 ft.



- Eliminate self-service dispensers, salad bars and uncovered food items to prevent the contamination of food



- Some kitchens have an island with self-service equipment
- An attendant can “serve” or portion these foods for students



- Gloves are necessary for touching ready to eat food



- Whenever possible, pay with non-cash methods



- Observe distance with tables and chairs



- Provide opportunities for kids to spread out, to use barriers or to eat in classrooms



- Whenever possible, pre-bag or pre-package food items for efficient and sanitary dissemination to customers
